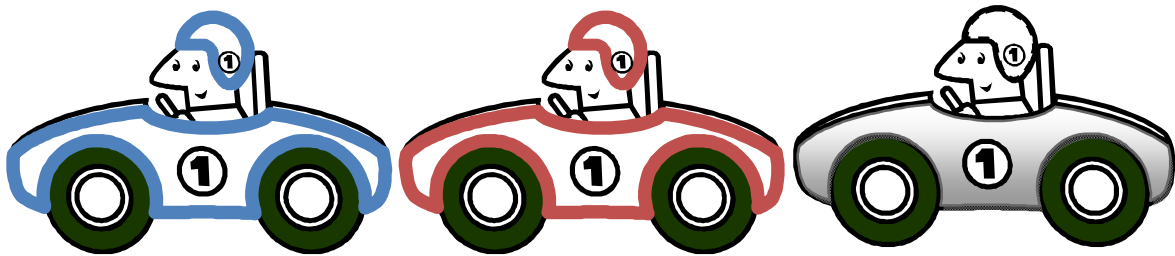

AUTHORITY

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, Victorian Hillclimb Championship Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations or instructions that may be issued, and will be subject to CAMS PERMIT NO: **310/0606/04**

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be a Round 5 of the 2010 Victorian Hillclimb Championship, to be conducted at Mt Leura rd Camperdown on Saturday 5th & Sunday 6th June 2010. This event is a round of the 2010 CAMS NGK Junior Pentathlon Series.

ENTRIES

Entries open upon publication these Supplementary Regulations and close on Wednesday 2nd June 2010

The entry fee is \$88.00. (NGK Junior pentathlon series competitor is \$50.00). Both include GST.

Cheques and Money Orders should be made payable to **Ararat Car Club Inc**

Entry forms must be completed in full accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting by the closing date.

The Promoters have arranged Public Risk Insurance to the requirements of Appendix I of the NCR. The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for this event. Priority will be given to log booked championship eligible vehicles. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83.

COMPETITION

- OPTIONAL PRACTICE will commence at 1.00 pm and conclude at approx 5 pm on Saturday 5th June 2010.
- THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICE ON SUNDAY 6th June 2010.
- Each competitor will have a minimum of **FOUR OFFICIAL TIMED RUNS**.

PERSONS ELIGIBLE

The event shall be open to members of clubs affiliated with CAMS who are holders of a current CAMS level 2SJ, 2S or higher licence

VEHICLE SCRUTINY

A. Optional Practice Day - On Saturday 5th June 2010. Scrutiny will commence at 10.30am and conclude at 5 pm

B. Competition Day - On Sun 6th June 2010 - scrutiny will commence at 8.00am in the Cattle Pavilion if needed and conclude at 9.00am

All vehicles must be scrutineered and passed for practice and competition prior to participation. CAMS Licences, Competition Records and current Club Membership Cards must be produced at scrutiny and on request during the meeting

All vehicles must pass Scrutiny prior to competition. CAMS Licences, and current Club Membership Cards must be produced at the Event Secretary's office prior to going to scrutiny.

ALL VEHICLES COMPETING IN THE 2010 VICTORIAN HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP MUST HAVE A CAMS LOG BOOK which must be presented at Scrutiny. Entries will be accepted from competitors/vehicles without a CAMS log Book, but these entries will only be accepted after all Log Booked entries have been accepted. Such competitors will not score points in the 2010 Victorian Hillclimb Championship.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

THE ATTENDANCE OF ALL DRIVERS IS COMPULSORY AT THE DRIVERS BRIEFING.

Competitors on Sunday will be required to attend the drivers briefing to be held at 9.15am on 6th June 2010. Drivers will be required to sign an attendance sheet. The starting order will be advised at the Drivers Briefing.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic, to 1/100th of a second. Event winners will be those competitors with the fastest time for a single run in each class.

PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with part XII of the NCR.

ABANDONMENT

The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59.

SAFETY - DRIVERS

Drivers must wear a CAMS approved helmet it must be deemed by vehicle scrutiny of the event to be in a suitable condition for motor sport use, non flammable clothing, including cover from ankles to wrist to throat, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 6, Schedule D of the CAMS Manual).

SAFETY - CARS

The attention of competitors is drawn to Section 6 of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. Vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher complying with Section 6, Schedule H of the CAMS Manual. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES

For Competitors entering multiple drivers in the same vehicle a separate entry form and fee will be required for each driver.

ALCOHOL

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the days of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate, refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews and officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24 hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

NOISE

All competing cars must be fitted with a device that restricts the exhaust noise level to a maximum of 95DBA (Ameasured at a distance of 30 meters on a drive by test under full acceleration. *Any competitor's car that exceeds this limit will be warned. A second offence will result in expulsion from the remainder of the meeting.*

COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competitors who have registered permanent numbers for the Victorian Hillclimb Championship will have preference. Please advise on the entry form if this is the case.

- I Sports Cars Open/Closed up to 1600cc
- J Sports Cars Open/Closed 1601 and over
- K Sports Cars – MGB up to 2000cc
- L Sports Sedans up to 1600
- M Sports Sedans 1601 to 2000
- N Sports Sedans 2001 and over
- O Sports Sedans – 4WD
- P Improved Production up to 1600
- Q Improved Production 1601 to 2000
- R Improved Production 2001 and over
- S Historic- Other
- T Historic Group N up to 2000
- U Historic Group N 2001 and over
- V Saloon Cars
- W Non Log Booked Cars

NOTE: Classes may, at the Promoters discretion, be combined where there are less than three entries in a class. Where there are sufficient entries, further classes may be created. Competitors in Historic Other, must provide a Certificate of Description for their vehicle.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the person achieving fastest time of day, and to the fastest and second fastest time in each class. Further awards may be made, and these will be notified to competitors in any further information that may be forwarded to competitors and/or at the Drivers Briefing.
